Invitation

Dear volleyball friends

The organization of the **XV Summer Cup 2014** is pleased to invite your prestigious club to participate in the fifteenth edition of this international youth volleyball tournament.

The event will be held in **2-6 July, in Portugal** at Lousã (28 km from Coimbra), Miranda do Corvo, Serpins, Gois and is aimed at teams from the following age groups:

- **U14** boys and girls: born in **2000** and after
- **U15** boys and girls: born in **1999** and after
- **U16** boys and girls: born in **1998** and after
- **U17** boys and girls: born in **1997** and after



Goals

- 1.** Extend the 2013/2014 competition season, thus maintaining the participating teams motivated to continue training beyond the regular season.
- 2.** Mark the end of the competition season through a tournament, where the parties and the moments of fraternization between the participating teams are a constant and give this event unique entertaining features.
- 3.** Gather at Lousã and adjacent municipalities the family of European youth volleyball
- 4.** Allow coaches to test the teams and players that will be part of these group ages for the 2014/2015 season. Especially important for teams that are still part of the mini volleyball competition this year but want to participate in the tournament to teach the 6x6 play.



Organization

The organization of the Summer Cup consists of about 15 elements that constitute the "core" group, with orange uniform.

In close partnership with these elements there are about 30 "collaborators". These elements are the operational staff of Summer Cup, in charge of with the play venues, transportation and meals. They wear Green and are responsible for proximity organizational tasks.

Similarly, Summer Cup has had the privilege of having a distinguished group of official referees who coordinate the refereeing for the event, together with about 100 volunteers.

In total, there are 150 elements performing organizational tasks that contribute to the achievement of one of the best volleyball tournaments in the world for young teams.

Accommodation

The accommodation will take place in **classrooms** in the schools:

- Escola Secundária da Lousã
- Escola EB 2/3 da Lousã
- Escola Primária da Lousã
- Escola Primária de Santa Rita (Lousã)
- Escola Secundária de Miranda do Corvo

Summer Cup Accommodation Rules:

1. The criteria for the distribution of the teams' accommodation are of the sole responsibility of the organization Summer Cup and may be adjusted in each edition.
2. The teams from foreign countries and autonomous regions of the Azores and Madeira are always housed in Escola Secundária da Lousã due to the need to travel before and after the start of the event.
3. The teams will be charged for the costs related to fixing damaged material in schools in result of its unauthorized or improper use.
4. The organization will provide one mattress per element, and each participant should bring a sleeping bag or sheets and pillow.
5. Teams wishing to be housed in another type of accommodation - Hotel, Inn, etc., are responsible for the corresponding fee and should make reservations directly with the hotel.

The meals will be prepared in **school canteens** and the participation fee for each team already includes their cost throughout the tournament for following meals:

Note: If clubs require "unofficial" meals (marked " No") should contact the restaurants directly. The organization may provide some contacts of restaurants but is not responsible for the reservation process.



U14 boys/girls (born after 2000) delegation

U15 boys/girls (born after 1999) delegation

The U14 and U15 delegations must have a minimum number of 10 elements: **9 athletes + 1 coach**

There is no maximum number of athletes per team, however the minimum of 10 elements is mandatory, of which 9 must be athletes.

This requirement relates to the mandatory presence of 9 players per match, in order to enforce the rules of players' change between sets.

It will be up to the teams and clubs decide whether it is better to bring one team with a higher number of players or two teams of the same age group/gender, even if one of the teams also includes players from a lower age group.

Similarly, player substitutions during sets are not allowed.

In the U14 and U15 competitions, the Portuguese Volleyball Federation regulations must be respected according to which, between sets, coaches have to change three players and no athlete can play in three consecutive sets.

The side box illustrates a situation where the coach made the minimum number of regulatory changes. Of course, the coach can change more than three changes so that 12 players can play.



U16 boys/girls (born after 1998) delegation

Objectives:

- To enable the participation of clubs with **U16** teams, consisting of a few U15 players, thus being able to compete within the same age group.
- To give teams the chance to participate with U15 teams if they do not have nine athletes to compete at that age group. They can still participate in the tournament in the U16 competition.
- To provide a tool for coaches of U15 teams to prepare for next season of U16 or U17 competition, playing without restrictions regarding players' change between sets
- the use of a libero is not allowed

U17 boys/girls (born after 1997) delegation

Objectives:

- To enable the participation of clubs with **U17** teams, consisting of a few U16 players, thus being able to compete within the same age group.
- To provide a tool for coaches of U17 teams to prepare for next season of U18 competition As a result, **the use of the Libero player will be allowed.**

In the U16 and U17 boys and girls competition, the minimum is 6 athletes. However, we advise teams to bring at least 8 players, allowing for the necessary change of players, thus preventing the occurrence of any injuries.

Given that, in some countries, there are differences in terminology and age group, athletes born in 1996 may play in this competition.



Registration Fee

To be able to organize an event of this dimension, the individual contribution of each participant through the Registration Fee is critical, which will serve to meet the following expenses:

→ Accommodation, 4 breakfasts, 4 lunches, 4 dinners, health and safety (6 Schools and 5 Sports Pavilions), physical therapy, refereeing, logistics, transportation, promotion, animation, etc.

In this year's edition, the registration fee will be **€ 90.**

The deadline for the fee payment is June 20 (fifteen days before the tournament starts). From that date, the registration fee will be 150 €.

Note - the entry fee applies to all elements of the delegation: coaches, managers, physical therapists, etc.

* Note: Special conditions only apply to teams with a minimum number of 9 players in the U14 and U15 competition. For the remaining competitions (U16 and U17), teams must have a minimum number of 8 players in order to qualify for these conditions.

Directions to Lousã - Portugal

If the teams from the autonomous regions of Azores and Madeira and foreign countries using airlines are interested in transportation between the Lisbon airport and Lousã (at approximately 220 km), they may request the collaboration of the organization.

The organization will provide buses that will transport several teams from Lisbon or Porto Airport to Lousã. In order to address the costs for the buses available to teams for each of the following routes:

- Lisbon Airport -> Lousã = 12,5 € per person
- Lousã -> Lisbon Airport = 12,5 € per person

Each member of the delegation is expected to contribute € 25 for the transportation.

► Obviously, the participating teams are not required to use the organization's transport in their travels to Lousã. If they wish, they may use the train network service (www.cp.pt) or the bus network service (www.rede-expressos.pt). The prices offered by the train or bus services are around 32 euros per ticket.

► If you opt for the SC official transportation, we ask the teams to arrive at the **Lisbon airport** since it is easier to organize transport using buses of 50 seats for the simultaneous transport of several teams.

► The Portuguese and foreign teams **traveling by air, we advise them to arrive on July 2nd, Tuesday, during the day.** The organization shall provide the teams one transport in the afternoon and another at night (with schedules adjusted as much as possible to the flight arrival times. Some teams may have to wait for the others).

► For the return, **we ask the teams to book their flights to Monday, July 7th.** If possible for late morning or afternoon, thus preventing leaving Lousã too early.

► It may be necessary that some teams have to leave Lousã early for the airport since, for logistical reasons, the bus should be as full as possible. So, teams whose flight schedules are closer to the first team leaving Lisbon should follow in the same bus.

The **organization will provide transportation** to all the games and activities of the tournament.



Summer Cup 2014 Registration Regulation

Point 1: Teams interested in participating should **register as early as possible considering that the payment deadline is June 20.**

Point 2: It is mandatory to formalize the registration via email:
lousavolleyclube@sapo.pt

Point 3: The only **selection criterion** of teams is the order of registration.

Point 4: The acceptance of registration is immediate (unless otherwise informed by the organization), so **any withdrawal must be notified immediately.**

Point 5: The **registration is only validated after the payment** of the registration fee.

Point 6: The organization will **send the receipt** of the payment after receiving the check. The club must provide the data to the organization in order to issue the receipts.

Point 7: Clubs may register as many teams as they wish.

Point 8: Registrations can **close before the deadline** if there is a large number of registrations, limited to the accommodation capacity.

Point 9: The **registration fee** for the tournament is:
→ € 90 / per element, if the fee is paid until 20 June
→ € 150 / per element, if the fee is paid after June 21 and during "Check-in".

Point 10: Teams must pay the registration fee in order to formalize their registration, by bank transfer or sending a **check** endorsed to "**Lousã Volley Clube**".

Point 11: The organization reserves the right not to return the amount already paid, if the team withdraws from the tournament after June 20th, 2014.

Point 12: It is mandatory that **U14 and U15** participate with the **minimum number of 9 players**. In case of any last minute event (injury, disease, etc.) and these athletes cannot be replaced, teams can participate in the tournament but are subject to specific rules regarding game forfeiting.



Point 13: For the **U16 and U17** competitions, the minimum number of players is 6, although we recommend bringing a larger delegation.

Point 14: It is the sole responsibility of the participating clubs to make sure that the athletes / coaches / managers and others who will represent the club possess sports insurance, as well as consent from parents.

In the absence of this insurance, teams must possess an insurance against personal injuries - sport, culture and recreation for the days of the event.

If the teams need help with this insurance, the tournament offers the service **"SC Insurance."**

- Teams, in the months before SC and at registration, must fill out the delegation form and mark the element that is not insured. With the data in this document (name and ID) the insurance company working with SC will issue the insurance.
- The expenses for this service are of the responsibility of the club and the payment must be made at "check-in".
